Types of Honors Courses

- **Honors foundations** include honors versions of required Core Education and major courses. Some HC courses also fulfill university or major requirements.
- **Honors seminar** courses offer unique topics and learning experiences
- **Thesis** credit requirements may be met with thesis, research and/or project credits related to the honors thesis.



Honors College Requirements

Maintain a 3.25 cumulative GPA

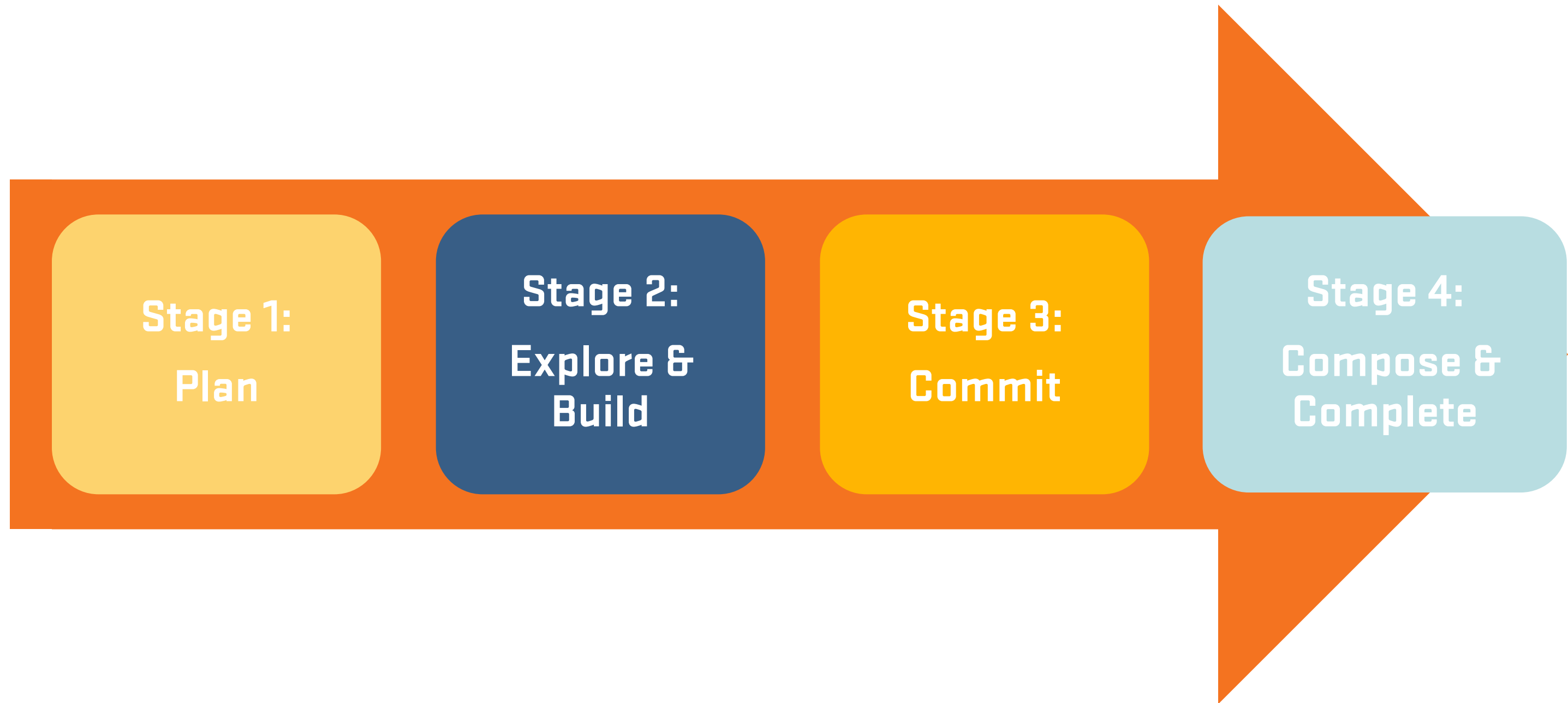
30 credits (Honors Scholar Track A)
